

Be a Responsible Tourist- Obey The Park Rules



“Because of popularity, the National parks are getting overcrowded. Inappropriate behaviour by visitors is causing distress to animals and damage to the environment. Your help is needed to preserve the park and animals and ensure a satisfying experience to all visitors.”

How you can help?

- Do not encourage driving too close to animals, overcrowding them or chasing after them. This causes distress to the animals.
- Refrain from off-roading .Stick to designated paths. Off-roading damages habitats.
- Stick to prescribed times. Enter and leave the park at opening and closing times.
- Stick to prescribed speed limits.
- Give everyone a chance to watch wildlife.
- Ask to switch off engine when you stop to watch wildlife.
- Do not shout. Avoid noise pollution, point rather than speak.
- Keep mobile phones on silent mode.
- Never climb out of your vehicle or stand on the roof.
- Do not use flash when taking photographs.
- Refrain from smoking or drinking alcohol within a national park.
- Do not encourage or feed the animals. They are wild and must stay so.

Follow these rules. Make sure that your driver also does so.
